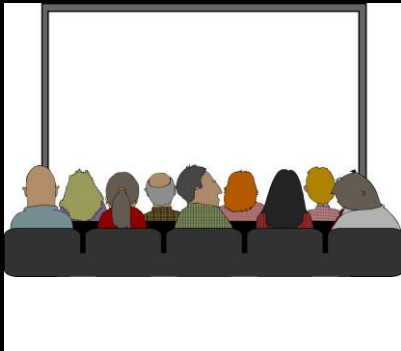

**VOLUNTEERS AND COMMITTEES WANTED!!!!!!**

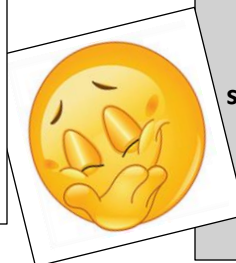
Currently we need a new **RINK BOARD** to run next year. All elected positions are vacant;

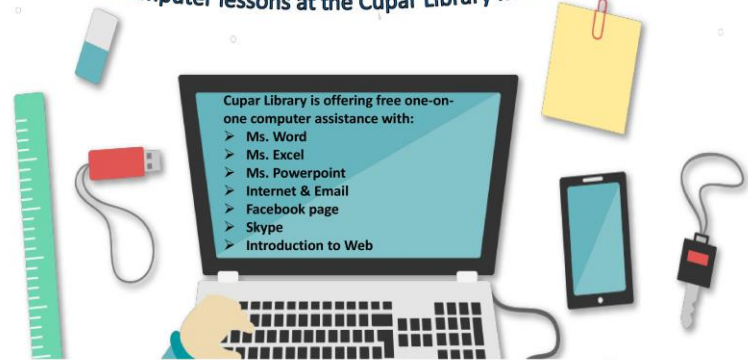
We are open on Wednesdays and Fridays in the Legion Hall from 10:30-5:00 pm.

**Street sweeping and Spring cleaning**

Street sweeping/cleaning will be beginning as soon as weather permits! As we are sweeping/cleaning we ask that you try to keep your vehicles and bins off the street so we can have a clear route to clean things up.

As yards are being cleaned please use biodegradable bags for anything you want to be picked up by Town Maintenance. Any bags that are not biodegradable will be left for the home owner to deal with. You can then either place them in your grey bin or take them out to the transfer site when it opens. If you take them to the transfer site, you may be required to split and empty them in the appropriate location.

Please make sure branches and twigs are bundled and placed where the tractor can access them easily but not on the roadway in the way of traffic.
