Dogs and Cats

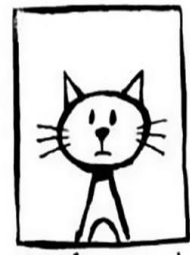
Dogs and Cats are not to be running at large and please ensure they are on a leash when out. Pick up any droppings your animal leaves behind and discard in a proper receptacle.

PARKING

This creates problems for access to get through on the streets, visibility concerns and causes more issues when we are trying to sweep or repair. Further, there have been incidents of people parking on the boulevard by their houses. This is not permitted for any period of time and you run the risk of being towed - at your expense.

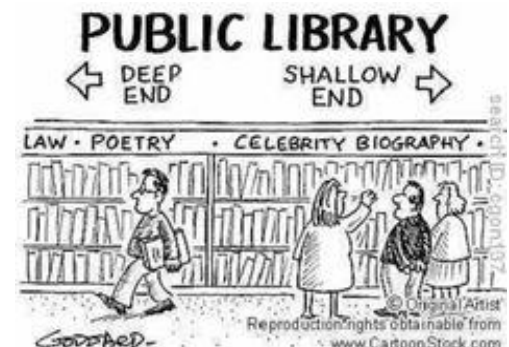

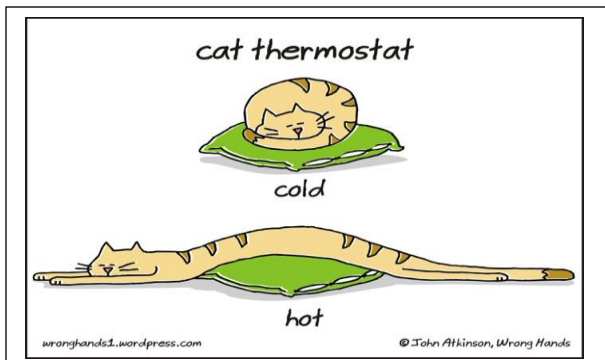
