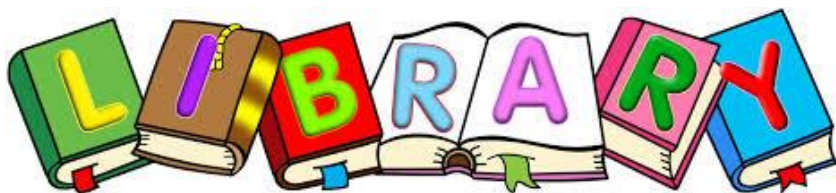

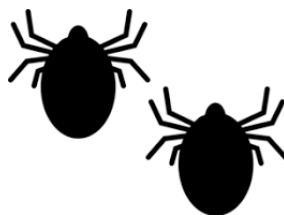

Gardening Tips & Ideas!

Tips for beginners:

-If you're a first-time gardener, make sure not to plant too much to overwhelm yourself. Start small and build from there.

-Plant mostly what you and your family eats. Starting with things you know you will use will make gardening much more rewarding.

-Pay attention to spacing plants properly when planting your garden. Every

plant requires its own unique amount of area needed to produce properly!

-Pay attention to if plants are to grow in the shade or sun. This is very important for the harvest of your plants.

-Buy your plants like peppers and tomatoes. Starting seeds is a lot of fun and can be very rewarding, but if this is your first-time gardening, it's easier and more practical to just buy the baby plants at the store.

-Keep a garden journal of what you planted each year and where you planted it. Keep track of your harvest of all your plants as well.

-Put crushed egg shells, coffee grounds and vegetable and fruit scraps to your garden to add much needed nutrients back into the soil.

- To help conserve water get a rain barrel that you can use to water your garden.

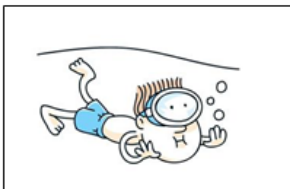
