



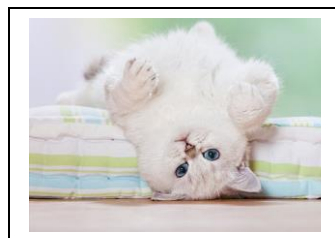

## Spring Cleaning and yard care 2016

This year we begin our Bio-degradable bag pick up for Leaf and Grass Clippings. This is mandatory and will be implemented this spring. All grass clippings and leaf rakings that is placed out for maintenance to pick up MUST be in a bio-degradable bags. Any bags left for pick up that are NOT in bio-degradable bags will be left for the owner to dispose of on their own.

Further, we ask that you utilize your garbage bins and recycle bins as they were intended and ensure you care for the bins properly so they do not receive damage in your care. This includes removing them from the street after the pick-up has occurred and returning them to a safe place on your property as well as ensuring water does not sit in them.
