The annual meeting of the Cupar Museum will be held May 11<sup>th</sup> at 10:00 am at the museum. All members and other interested parties are invited.


# Cupar Public Library



**Around the Town**

Spring is here and yard work has begun. A few things to note while you are in the spring clean-up spirit:

1. Cupar Transfer Site does not open until Saturday May 21<sup>st</sup> and hours of operation are dependent on getting a weekend worker for out there or if it will be our maintenance crew. Please stay tuned for more info as we know.
2. Leaf/grass clippings – will only be picked up if they are in biodegradable bags. Any other bags will be left for the owner to dispose of. A few of those options are using your grey bin or taking them to the transfer site when it is open. There is no charge to do this however you will be required to empty the bags on site.
3. Trees – we do not pick up trees that are cut down by the homeowners. We do pick up occasionally the twigs or branches from trimming your trees to keep them maintained. The homeowner is responsible to remove and dispose of their own tree cuttings. This too can be taken to the transfer site when it is open at no charge. You will be required to put the branches and such in the appropriate location when there.

Street sweeping has begun and will continue as needed. Please try to stay out of the sweepers way so we can get things as clean as possible.



Registrations are accepted on a first come first served basis.


Registration forms are available online and in the Town Office. If you would like one emailed to you, please contact us at 306.723.4324 and one will be send asap.
