PET RULES

The Cupar Town Office has been receiving numerous complaints regarding pets and their owners. We would like to take this time to review the rules and regulations of owning a pet and your obligations:

1. All pets must be on a leash at all times when out of their yards.
2. Any defecation or feces left by your pet **MUST** be picked up and disposed of in a proper manner. Please do not leave it on someone else's yard, school property or boulevard. It is unsightly, unsanitary and not neighborly.
3. All pets must be registered with the Town Office and have their identification tag on their collar.
4. No pets allowed to be running free. All pets are essentially animals and their behavior cannot be guaranteed at all times. Please make the town safe for everyone to enjoy it.
