DID YOU KNOW....

Regina is home to the world's longest bridge over the shortest span of water. The Albert Street or Albert Memorial Bridge, built in 1903, crossed tiny little Wascana Creek and spans an incredible 850 feet. The creek is only a few feet wide.

If you are like many people, you think hot dogs and hamburgers taste better with mustard. Chances are good that the mustard you use comes from Saskatchewan. Since the 1950s the area has been responsible for up to 75 percent of all mustard grown in Canada, producing over 150,000 tons in 2010.

The first automated teller machine in Canada was developed by Saskatchewan credit unions in 1977 and first went into service at two Sherwood Credit Union branches (now Conexus Credit Union) in Regina



BYLAW OFFICER

Many of our residents have been asking about our bylaw officer. Here is a little information about what he is doing in Cupar.

We will be having weekly visits from our officer to help keep our town clean, healthy and safe.

-Bylaw Enforcement's role is to promote, facilitate and enforce general compliance with the provisions of our towns bylaws that pertain to the safety and security of the community.

Bylaw Enforcement Officers are responsible for:

- -Working with residents and community groups to resolve issues through education and enforcement to achieve bylaw compliance
- -Investigating property complaints
- -Coordinating investigations with internal and external enforcement




