

### Your water meter is getting an upgrade.

The Town of Cupar is modernizing its water system infrastructure to provide the community with better water conservation and leak detection, as well as reduce the cost of operation.

As the Town of Cupar's authorized installer, CORIX Water Products will be replacing residential and commercial water meters throughout the Town.
