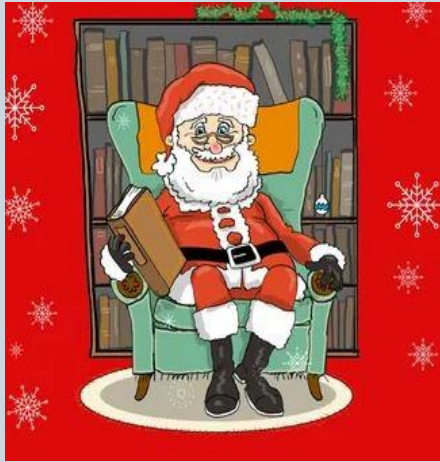

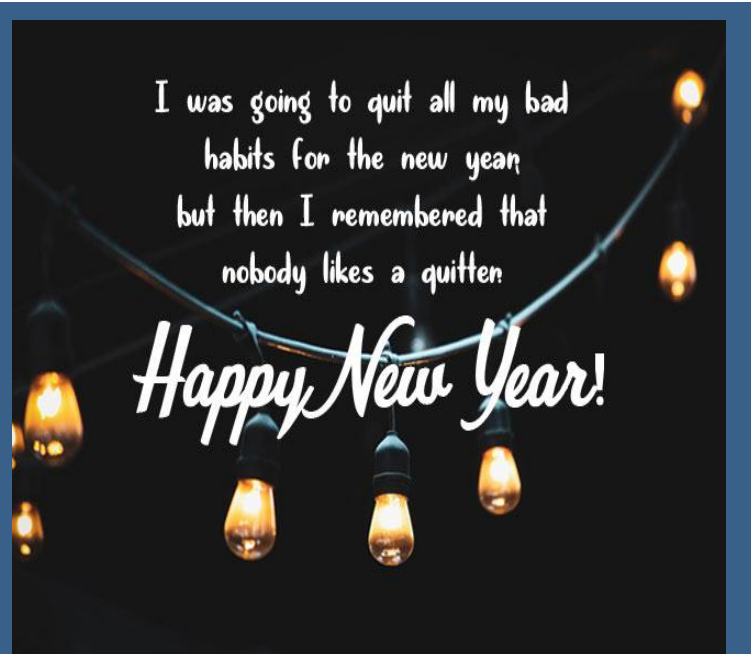

1. Pet Licenses are due January 1 for the 2020 year as per Bylaw 12-2008.
2. Taxes are due December 31, 2019. Any outstanding taxes owing will start to accrue interest monthly January 2020.
3. Grey/Blue bins are to be set out the night before pick up and returned to your property right after they have been emptied. This will keep them safe from damage. Any carts damaged from irresponsible care is about \$120 to replace.
4. Snow removal will begin – when we get snow – so, to prepare for it, please move your vehicles off of the street. This will allow the grader and blower to clean the gutters closer to the edge so drainage works properly.
5. Don't forget the FREE Public Skating on Sundays from 3-5 pm at the Cupar Rink. This has been sponsored in part by the Town of Cupar.
