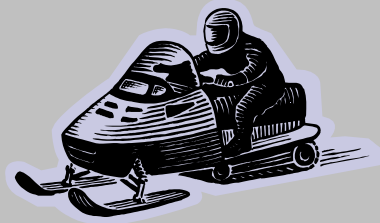

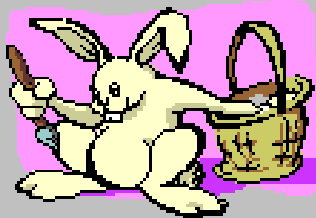

Re/Plumbing & Sewer

Dear Residents,

It has been brought to our attention that many homes do not provide the required area or 4” cleanout for plumbers to properly access the sewer lines within their homes. Without proper access to the sewer lines, the plumbers are unable to guarantee a complete cleanout of the lines. The town will not be responsible for any incurred costs related to these cleanings regardless where the blockage occurs.

It is the homeowners’ responsibility to ensure that both the area for performing the work is available as well as the 4” access to the sewer line.
