## SPRING/SUMMER EVENTS














During these strange times some of our events and town operations have had to be adjusted. While we understand it is not the most favorable options, we felt we had no choice at this time:

1. Pool – At this time we are unsure the pool will open. Even if we received notification that the pool could be opened in the next month, we would not have the time required to prepare, fill and get the pool up and running for the health inspector. All permits for pools have been rescinded so we do not have plans to proceed.
2. July 1<sup>st</sup> celebrations – these have been cancelled. We are looking into something for the day in the way of fireworks which can be done safely and with social distancing so please stay tuned.
3. Community Garage Sale – this has been cancelled. The Saskatchewan Government has asked that no one holds garage sales at this time.
4. No social gatherings over 10 people. We have been receiving reports of some groups that are larger than 10 so please limit the amount of people you socialize with during the re-opening of Saskatchewan. It is much easier to trace who you have been in contact with when you limit the people – in the event someone is being tested.
5. Transfer Site – will be closed for the 2020 season. We will still be picking up grass clippings, leaves and small amounts of tree trimming. If you have a large number of trees or leaves and you wish to take them out to the transfer site please contact the town office to arrange a date and time for someone to let you in. We will only be accepting the trees, leaves and grass clippings. All other waste will have to be hauled to the Landfill in the city or one of your choice OR disposed of in your grey bin that is tipped weekly. If you want another grey bin please contact the Town Office. All charges will be applied on your utility bill.
6. Branches – we prefer the smaller amounts of trees to be placed at the front for pick up. If you have no way to do so please call the office to advise and we will relay the location to the maintenance team. Please note, if the alleys are wet, we will not travel down them in the heavy equipment so there may be a delay when they are picked up for the alley to dry.
7. The Town Office is still closed to the public but we are still in there Monday to Friday and available by email and phone.

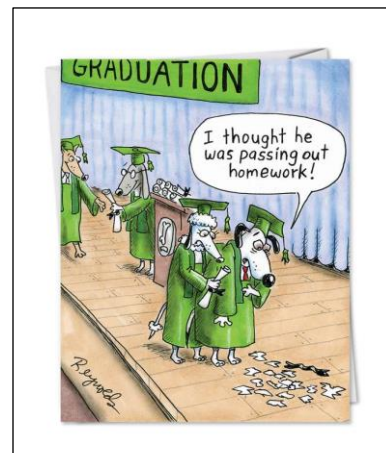
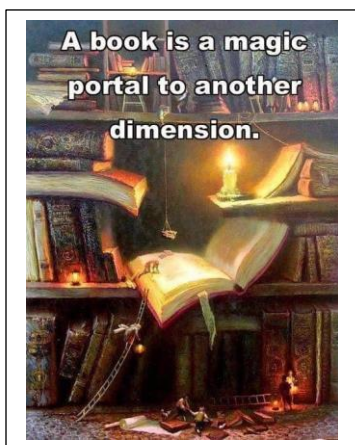

## JUST A FEW THINGS

- When cutting your grass DO NOT have it shoot out onto the streets. The grass plugs up our drainage system which does not allow the rain to dissipate at a proper rate.
- Dog/Cat licenses are still required. Make sure your dog/cat has a license from the town as per Bylaw 12-2008.
- QUADS ARE NOT ALLOWED IN TOWN. We have far too many issues with quads and dirt bikes in town. Whether they are driving on the streets, which is not allowed by the RCMP, or destroying the grass, ditches or yards in town – these are not permitted and should be reported immediately to the local RCMP detachment.
- The next Town meeting is May 19<sup>th</sup> at the Cupar Town Hall. The location is to allow the social distancing that is required and we are under the maximum number of 10 people allowed.
- Remember to wash your hands often. When you head out to pick up what you need whether it is groceries, hardware or pharmacy make sure you wash your hands often to avoid the possible spreading of the virus. You may be clean and not be ill but one wrong touch and the virus is spreading – let's keep our community safe.
- Please ensure all recycle items placed in the recycle bin are appropriate and allowed. One wrong item can contaminate the entire truck.
- The Cupar Nursing Home used to have a plaque that displayed all the centennial birthdays. That plaque will now be relocated to our office and maintained by the Town of Cupar. If you or your loved one has reached that milestone centennial birthday please confirm with the Town of Cupar so we can add it to the plaque and have it displayed proudly.
- The Town Office will be closed for May 18<sup>th</sup> in observance of Victoria Day.
